

## RoHS Directive

The RoHS Directive (the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment) is intended to reduce the use of substances that may pose risks to human health or the environment. The RoHS laws state that after July 1, 2006 most new electrical and electronic equipment cannot be sold if it contains the following substances above specified concentrations at the homogeneous material level:

**Lead (0.1%)**

**Mercury (0.1%)**

**Cadmium (0.01%)**

**Hexavalent chromium (0.1%)**

**Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%)**

**Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1%)**
