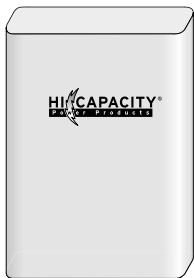

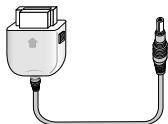
1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Hi-Capacity® iPod External Battery.

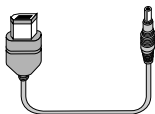
The iPod External Battery contains the following items:

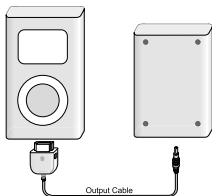
2. Safety Precautions

The iPod External Battery is composed of Lithium-Ion batteries with a high energy density. It is designed to provide safe, efficient power for the iPod MP3 player series.

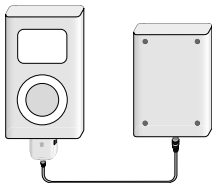
Safety instructions

- Only use with iPod series models.
- Do not disassemble, puncture, throw, drop, crush, bend or modify the iPod External Battery.
- Only use the iPod power adapter and provided firewire cable for charging the iPod External Battery.
- Do not short-circuit the connectors with metal objects.
- Avoid placing the iPod External Battery in direct sunlight, next to heat-sensitive materials or in automobiles where extreme temperatures may result.
- Do not submerge or expose the iPod External Battery to water or any other liquid.
- Always store the battery in a cool, dry area.
- Do not allow children to play with the iPod External Battery.

3. Operation of the iPod External Battery



- A) Insert the end of the output cable into the input port of the iPod MP3 player.



- B) Insert the other end of the output cable into the iPod External Battery.

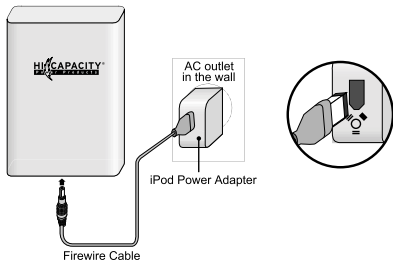


- C) Using the silicon band, bind the iPod and iPod External Battery together.

Note: If the iPod External Battery becomes abnormally hot, disconnect the output cable from the iPod MP3 player. Wait until it cools down, then connect to the iPod again.

Note: The iPod External Battery will provide extended run time for the iPod mini series, but will not recharge the internal battery.

4. Charging the iPod External Battery



- Connect the firewire cable to the iPod External Battery.
- Connect the AC adapter into the AC outlet in the wall.
- Plug the firewire cable into the AC adapter firewire port.

* How to read LED

- Green : Charging

- Off : Charging completed

- Blinking : Charging error. (In this case, disconnect the Firewire cable from the AC adapter for 30 minutes)
